### **How much will the hotel cost?**

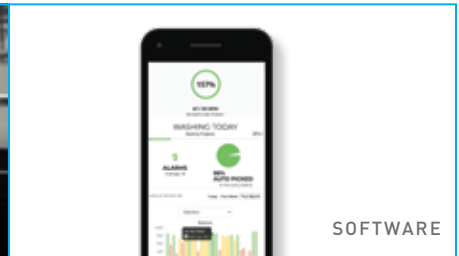
